1	Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:
2	Sec. 1. 38 MRSA §353, sub-§9 is enacted to read:
3	9. Finance charges. In addition to other remedies specifically authorized in this
4	Title, the department shall charge interest at a rate of 15% per annum and may pursue
5	enforcement, including, but not limited to, penalties pursuant to section 349 and
6	suspension or revocation pursuant to section 341-D, subsection 3 for the failure of a
7	licensee to pay any portion of licensing fees owed by the date due.
8	SUMMARY
9	The bill adds bill collecting standard practices to the Department of Environmental
10	Protection's financial management authority.
