An Act To Amend the Staffing and Reporting Requirements for the Citizen Trade Policy Commission

1 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

Sec. 1. 10 MRSA §11, sub-§9, ¶C, as enacted by PL 2003, c. 699, §2, is
 amended to read:

C. Shall <u>every 2 years</u> conduct an <u>annual</u> assessment of the impacts of international
trade agreements on Maine's state laws, municipal laws, working conditions and
business environment. The assessment must be submitted and made available to the
public as provided for in the annual report in paragraph D;

8 Sec. 2. 10 MRSA §11, sub-§9, ¶D, as enacted by PL 2003, c. 699, §2, is 9 amended to read:

10 Shall maintain active communications with and submit an annual report to the D. 11 Governor, the Legislature, the Attorney General, municipalities, Maine's 12 congressional delegation, the Maine International Trade Center, the Maine Municipal Association, the United States Trade Representative's Office, the National 13 Conference of State Legislatures and the National Association of Attorneys General 14 or the successor organization of any of these groups. The commission shall make the 15 report easily accessible to the public by way of a publicly accessible site on the 16 Internet maintained by the State. The report must contain information acquired 17 18 pursuant to activities under paragraphs paragraph B and may contain information 19 acquired pursuant to activities under paragraph C;

20 Sec. 3. 10 MRSA §12 is enacted to read:

21 <u>§12. Quorum</u>

For purposes of holding a meeting, a quorum is 11 members. A quorum must be
 present to start a meeting but not to continue or adjourn a meeting. For purposes of
 voting, a quorum is 9 voting members.

SUMMARY

This bill changes the frequency with which the Citizen Trade Policy Commission must conduct an assessment of the impact international trade agreements have on Maine's state laws, municipal laws, working conditions and business environment from annually to every 2 years. It also establishes what constitutes a quorum and provides funding for a full-time staff position.
