Four medical representatives: 2 representatives of hospitals, nominated by the
 Maine Hospital Association; one representative of a statewide association of physicians,
 nominated jointly by the Maine Medical Association and the Maine Osteopathic
 Association; and one representative of the ambulatory surgical centers;

26 2. Three other representatives: one representative of a statewide association
 27 representing nursing facilities; one representative of insurance carriers; and one
 28 representative of the Advisory Council on Health Systems Development; and
