- 1 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:
- 2 Sec. 1. 23 MRSA §1913-A, sub-§1, ¶G, as amended by PL 1999, c. 152, Pt. G,
- 3 §2, is further amended to read:
- 4 G. Hand-held or similar signs not affixed to the ground or buildings; and
- 5 **Sec. 2. 23 MRSA §1913-A, sub-§1, ¶H,** as amended by PL 1999, c. 152, Pt. G,
- 6 §2, is repealed.
- 7 SUMMARY
- This bill repeals the authority to erect campaign signs on public property.
