1 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:**

2 **Sec. 1. 23 MRSA §1913-A, sub-§1, ¶G**, as amended by PL 1999, c. 152, Pt. G,
3 §2, is further amended to read:

4 G. Hand-held or similar signs not affixed to the ground or buildings; and

5 **Sec. 2. 23 MRSA §1913-A, sub-§1, ¶H**, as amended by PL 1999, c. 152, Pt. G,
6 §2, is repealed.

7 SUMMARY

8 This bill repeals the authority to erect campaign signs on public property.
