1 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:**

2 **Sec. 1. 30-A MRSA §2304**, as enacted by PL 1987, c. 737, Pt. A, §2 and Pt. C,
3 §106 and amended by PL 1989, c. 6; c. 9, §2; and c. 104, Pt. C, §§8 and 10, is further
4 amended to read:

5 **§2304. Tax status**

6 Regional councils established in accordance with this Title are tax-exempt
7 institutions ~~which~~ that are exempt only from income and sales taxes, except for the
8 provisions of Title 36, section 651, subsection 1, paragraph H.

9 **Sec. 2. 36 MRSA §651, sub-§1, ¶D** is amended to read:

10 D. The property of any public municipal corporation of ~~this~~ the State appropriated to
11 public uses, ~~if~~ whether located within the corporate limits and confines of ~~such~~ the
12 public municipal corporation or within the corporate limits and confines of another
13 public municipal corporation.

14 **Sec. 3. 36 MRSA §651, sub-§1, ¶H** is enacted to read:

15 H. The property of a regional council under Title 30-A, chapter 119 formed by 2 or
16 more municipalities to promote intergovernmental cooperation.

17 **SUMMARY**

18 This bill exempts from the property tax municipal property located in another
19 municipality and the property of a regional council formed by 2 or more municipalities to
20 promote intergovernmental cooperation.
