HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1129,  
L.D. 1607, Bill, "An Act To Establish a Fund to Provide American Flags at Veterans'  
Graves"

Amend the amendment by striking out all of section 1 and inserting the following:

'Sec. 1. 37-B MRSA §504, sub-§5, as amended by PL 2007, c. 167, §5, is further  
amended to read:

5. Weekend visitation. The ~~superintendent~~ director of the cemetery system shall  
arrange for public access during weekend daylight hours and regularly scheduled  
weekday visiting hours unless closure of the cemetery is considered necessary by the  
~~superintendent~~ director for security or public safety purposes.'

SUMMARY

This amendment is being presented on behalf of the Committee on Bills in the  
Second Reading to prevent a conflict by incorporating a change made to the Maine  
Revised Statutes, Title 37-B, section 504, subsection 5 in Public Law 2007, chapter 167.
