- 1 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:
- 2 Sec. 1. 20-A MRSA §13015, sub-§6 is enacted to read:

<u>6. Rules.</u> Rules adopted pursuant to this section are major substantive rules pursuant
 to Title 5, chapter 375, subchapter 2-A.

Sec. 2. Rulemaking suspended. All rulemaking by the Department of
Education, State Board of Education pursuant to the Maine Revised Statutes, Title 20-A,
§13015 that is not of a major substantive rule pursuant to Title 5, chapter 375, subchapter
2-A is suspended.

SUMMARY

10 This bill requires rules adopted by the Department of Education, State Board of 11 Education concerning support systems required as part of the certification of educational 12 personnel be major substantive rules under the Maine Administrative Procedure Act and

13 suspends all rulemaking of a rule that is not a major substantive rule.

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
