1 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:**

2 **Sec. 1. 32 MRSA §2158** is enacted to read:

3 **§2158. Certified nursing assistant training**

4 A program approved by the board for the clinical training of a certified nursing
5 assistant must have a trainer-to-student ratio of not less than 1 to 5.

6 **SUMMARY**

7 This bill requires that a clinical training program for certified nursing assistants have
8 a trainer-to-student ratio of not less than 1 to 5.
