- 1 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:
- 2 Sec. 1. 36 MRSA §1760, sub-§7-D is enacted to read:

3 <u>7-D. Vegetable seeds and fertilizer used for noncommercial production of</u>
4 <u>certain crops.</u> Sales of vegetable seeds and fertilizer for noncommercial production of
5 agricultural crops intended for human consumption.

6 Sec. 2. Application. This Act applies to sales occurring on or after October 1, 2007.
