## **SUMMARY**

This bill establishes the Town Academy Advisory Council in the Department of
Education. Its members are unpaid gubernatorial appointees representing heads and
trustees of town academies and public school superintendents. The council is required to
advise the Commissioner of Education on the needs of the town academies and to
facilitate communication among the academies, the department and school
superintendents.
