before March 1, 2004 and, at least 3 1/2¢ for containers picked up on or after March 1, 2004 and at least 4¢ for containers picked up on or after March 1, 2008. The initiator of the deposit may reimburse the dealer or local redemption center directly or indirectly through a contracted agent or through a party with which it has entered into a commingling agreement.

## SUMMARY

This amendment replaces the bill and is the minority report of the committee. It
reduces the minimum refund value for wine and spirits containers of greater than 50
milliliters to not less than 5¢ beginning April 1, 2008. It also increases the handling fee
for beverage containers to at least 4¢ for containers picked up on or after March 1, 2008.
