Fiscal Detail and Notes

This amendment increases the ongoing General Fund cost of the bill by \$97,800 per year beginning in fiscal year 2008-09. This amendment eliminates the provisions in the bill that increased the amount of fines and penalties that may be assessed on employers who violate the minimum wage and overtime laws.
