1 2	CONCEPT DRAFT SUMMARY
3	This resolve is a concept draft pursuant to Joint Rule 208.
4 5	This resolve proposes to establish a commission to review State House and Capitol complex security issues. In conducting the review, the commission shall explore:
6 7	1. Different means of screening visitors to the Capitol complex for weapons, including but not limited to knives, firearms and objects that may be used as weapons;
8 9 10	2. Creative methods of enhancing the security presence in the capitol complex, including but not limited to the recruitment of experienced retired law enforcement officers;
11 12 13	3. Methods of facilitating continuing education opportunities for capitol complex security personnel that are specifically targeted to enhancing the performance of the duties of security personnel; and
14 15	4. The availability of creative funding for enhanced security, including but not limited to federal funds and outside funding.
