1	Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:
2	Sec. 1. 36 MRSA §654, sub-§1, ¶G is enacted to read:
3	G. The homestead as defined in section 681 of a person who is 65 years of age or
4	older and whose income is below the poverty thresholds for persons 65 years of age
5	or older most recently established by the United States Census Bureau.
6	SUMMARY
7	This bill provides an exemption from residential property taxes for the home of a
8	person who is 65 years of age or older and whose income is below poverty thresholds.
