Amend the resolution by striking out all of the question (page 1, lines 23 to 25 in L.D.) and inserting the following:

16 ' "Do you favor amending the Constitution of Maine to require that certain
17 transportation-related revenues be placed in the Highway Fund and to require that all
18 funds in the Highway Fund be used solely for specified transportation-related
19 purposes?" '

**SUMMARY** 

21 This amendment clarifies the changes to Article IX, Section 19 of the Constitution of 22 Maine proposed by the bill. Under this amendment the constitutional provision will 23 require the creation of a Highway Fund, require that certain revenues be placed in that 24 fund, allow other funds to be placed in the fund and require that all funds in that fund be used solely for certain transportation-related purposes. Transportation-related purposes 25 include construction, reconstruction, maintenance and repair of public highways and 26 27 bridges under the direction and supervision of the Department of Transportation; 28 providing, operating, managing and maintaining the Maine State Ferry Service; and state 29 enforcement of traffic laws.
