1 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

2 CONCEPT DRAFT 3 SUMMARY

4 This bill is a concept draft pursuant to Joint Rule 208.

5 This bill proposes to establish a pricing formula for liquor sales and to adjust agent 6 discounts. The pricing formula should promote transparency, enhance market 7 predictability, promote fairness and increase Maine's competitiveness with neighboring 8 states. Agent discounts should increase incrementally, be funded through increased 9 revenues and other sources and be revenue-neutral to the State.
