Current Costs - Legislative Study

#### Legislative Study

The general operating expenses of the Alternative Education Programs Committee are projected to be \$4,490 in fiscal year 2007-08. The Legislature's proposed budget includes \$30,000 in fiscal year 2007-08 for legislative studies. Whether the amount is sufficient to fund all studies will depend on the number of studies authorized by the Legislative Council and the Legislature.

### **Fiscal Detail and Notes**
