Fiscal Detail and Notes

This amendment makes adjustments to Highway Fund allocations to the Department of Transportation, eliminates proposed increases for certain motor vehicle related fees that are deposited into the Highway Fund, deletes the GARVEE bond authorization which was enacted in a previous public law and eliminates those elements of the bill affecting General Fund appropriations and revenue.
