SENATE AMENDMENT “B” to H.P. 1262, L.D. 1810, Bill, “An Act To Enact the Informed Growth Act”


Amend the bill in section 1 in subchapter 3-A by inserting after §4370 the following:

§4371. Municipal waiver option

By vote of its municipal officers, a municipality may waive its right to apply the provisions of this subchapter to an application for a land use permit.

This amendment adds a municipal waiver option for a municipality to waive the right to apply the provisions for a land use permit by vote of its municipal officers.

Eliminates the state mandate

Fiscal Detail and Notes

This amendment allows a municipality the option to waive the right to apply the provisions under the Informed Growth Act for a land use permit and removes the state mandate. As amended, the bill still provides a \$40,000 fee charged to permit applicants to be paid to the State Planning Office as reimbursement to municipalities for activities still required if the option to waive is not exercised.
