HOUSE AMENDMENT "B" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to S.P. 648,
L.D. 1819, "RESOLUTION, Proposing an Amendment to the Constitution of Maine To
Restrict Tax Increases"

Amend the amendment in the 2nd indented paragraph in the last line (page 1, line 16
in amendment) by striking out the following: "Legislature; and" and inserting the
following: "Legislature. The 2/3 vote requirement of this subsection does not apply to
legislation that is subject to a statewide referendum before it may take effect; and"

Amend the amendment after the 3rd indented paragraph in the question in the last
line (page 1, line 22 in amendment) by inserting after the following: "payment" the
following: 'and except for statewide referenda'

SUMMARY

This amendment would exempt from the 2/3 vote requirement any legislation subject
to a referendum.
