

Fiscal Detail and Notes

Increasing the registration fee for defensive driving courses will increase dedicated revenue collected by the Department of Public Safety by an estimated \$3,750 and \$5,000 in fiscal years 2007-08 and 2008-09, respectively. This fiscal note corrects the fiscal note shown in Committee Amendment "A" which incorrectly identified the revenue increase as being to the Highway Fund.
