SUMMARY

4 This amendment changes "any other jurisdiction" to "another jurisdiction" to be consistent with the Maine Criminal Code. The amendment removes the term "coworker" 5 6 from the definition of "close relation," while adding persons with professional 7 relationships. The amendment also strikes the last sentence of the Maine Revised Statutes, Title 17-A, section 1252, subsection 5-D, which would have prohibited courts 8 9 from suspending that portion of the maximum term of imprisonment based on objective or subjective victim impact in arriving at the final sentence in the 3rd step in the 10 sentencing process. The amendment also strikes 2 words in the legislative intent section. 11

Correctional and Judicial Impact Statements

This legislation expands the scope of prohibited conduct and aggravating factors of an offense as it relates to a Class D crime, elevating it to a Class C crime if the actor has prior convictions. This will increase the average length of stay by 1 year and 4 months (486 days) and must be served in a state correctional facility. The average increased cost to the state for each occurrence is \$50,165. The Judicial Department indicates that increasing minimum sentences by "assigning special weight " could require additional judicial resources for processing these cases. However, this bill could also prevent escalating violence and result in a reduction of trial days and needed resources. The net effect should be minimal on the Judicial Department.
