HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1308,
L.D. 1876, "Resolve, Regarding the Maine State Cultural Building in Augusta"

Amend the amendment on page 2 in section 6 in the 2nd line (page 2, line 2 in amendment) by inserting after the following: "consultant." the following: 'For the purposes of funding the task force and the costs of an architectural consultant, the chair of the task force, on behalf of the task force, may apply for New Century Community Program funds, which may be matched by federal, state or local funds.'

SUMMARY

This amendment specifies that the task force may apply for New Century Community Program funds to provide funding for the task force and the architectural consultant; any funds received from the New Century Community Program are eligible to be matched by federal, state or local funds.
