11 Amend the resolve by striking out everything after the title and before the summary 12 and inserting the following:

13 'Sec. 1. Director of the Bureau of General Services to report on the status of the Maine State Cultural Building in Augusta. Resolved: That the Director 14 15 of the Bureau of General Services within the Department of Administrative and Financial Services, referred to in this resolve as "the director," shall provide a report on the status 16 17 and future of the Maine State Cultural Building in Augusta, taking into account the prior work on this topic, including the work of the task force authorized by Resolve 2005, 18 19 chapter 168. In preparing this report, the director shall consult with the Secretary of 20 State, who represents the task force established by Resolve 2005, chapter 168, and other 21 individuals or organizations determined by the director; and be it further

Sec. 2. Application authorized. Resolved: That the director is authorized to apply for grant money for funding, including from the New Century Community Program, and to expend in compliance with other applicable law any such funds received for architectural or other professional services in connection with the report required in section 1; and be it further

Sec. 3. Report. Resolved: That the director shall submit the report on the status and future of the Maine State Cultural Building pursuant to section 1 to the joint standing committee of the Legislature having jurisdiction over state and local government matters no later than February 1, 2009; and be it further

31 Sec. 4. Authority to report out legislation. Resolved: That the joint standing 32 committee of the Legislature having jurisdiction over state and local government matters 33 is authorized to submit legislation concerning the Maine State Cultural Building to the 34 First Regular Session of the 124th Legislature.'

### COMMITTEE AMENDMENT " " to H.P. 1308, L.D. 1876

#### **SUMMARY**

2 This resolve directs the Director of the Bureau of General Services within the 3 Department of Administrative and Financial Services, in consultation with the Secretary 4 of State, to provide a report regarding the status and future of the Maine State Cultural Building. It authorizes the director to apply for grant funding for this purpose, including 5 6 from the New Century Community Program. The director must report to the joint standing committee of the Legislature having jurisdiction over state and local government 7 matters by February 1, 2009, and the committee may submit legislation to the First 8 9 Regular Session of the 124th Legislature.
