1	Sec. 1. Adoption of rules governing swimming pools at day care facilities.
2	Resolved: That the Department of Health and Human Services shall adopt rules
3	governing the use of swimming pools at day care facilities and the safety of the children
4	using those swimming pools. Rules adopted pursuant to this section are major
5	substantive rules as defined in the Maine Revised Statutes, Title 5, chapter 375,
6	subchapter 2-A.

SUMMARY

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This resolve requires the Department of Health and Human Services to adopt major substantive rules to govern the safety of children at day care facilities that contain swimming pools.
