Sec. 1. Selling of property with buildings authorized. Resolved: That the Executive Department, State Planning Office is permitted to sell approximately 5 acres of land, with buildings, acquired by the State during the purchase of the West Old Town Landfill, to United Cerebral Palsy of Northeastern Maine for a nominal amount under such terms and conditions as are necessary or appropriate to effect this action.

SUMMARY

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This resolve directs the Executive Department, State Planning Office to sell a portion of the land, with buildings, acquired by the State during the purchase of the West Old Town Landfill. The action contemplated by this resolve fulfills the agreement the former landfill owner had with United Cerebral Palsy of Northeastern Maine, which operates a temporary care facility at the site.
