

HOUSE AMENDMENT "F" to H.P. 1362, L.D. 1925, Bill, "An Act To Cut Taxes on Maine Residents by over \$140,000,000"

Amend the bill in Part E in section 6 in subsection 2-D in the 2nd line (page 21, line 6 in L.D.) by inserting after the following: "individual" the following: ', not ordered or recommended by a physician or dentist,'

This amendment amends the bill to exempt from sales tax elective cosmetic medical procedures that are ordered or recommended by a physician or dentist.
