SENATE AMENDMENT "H" to H.P. 1362, L.D. 1925, Bill, "An Act To Cut Taxes on Maine Residents by over \$140,000,000"

Amend the bill in Part E in section 4 in subsection 1-I in the 5th line (page 20, line 27 in L.D.) by inserting after the following: "fairgrounds" the following: 'except for licensed agricultural fairs'

SUMMARY

This amendment excludes admission fees paid to licensed agricultural fairs from those amusement, entertainment and recreation services that are subject to sales tax.
