#### SUMMARY

8       This resolve amends Resolve 2005, chapter 201, which directs the Commissioner of  
9       Administrative and Financial Services to develop options for the long-term plans for the  
10      buildings formerly occupied by the Augusta Mental Health Institute and authorizes the  
11      Joint Standing Committee on State and Local Government to report out legislation  
12      regarding those plans to the First Regular Session of the 123rd Legislature. This resolve  
13      authorizes the joint standing committee to also report out legislation to the Second  
14      Regular Session of the 123rd Legislature.
