Whereas,** acts and resolves of the Legislature do not 2 become effective until 90 days after adjournment unless enacted as emergencies; and

3 Whereas, members of the Maine Regulatory Fairness Board do not receive any 4 compensation for their service on the board; and

5 Whereas, current law does not provide for members of that board to receive 6 reimbursement for their actual expenses incurred in connection with their service on the 7 board; and

8 Whereas, the inability to receive such reimbursement may adversely affect the 9 ability of some board members to continue to serve; and

Whereas, in the judgment of the Legislature, these facts create an emergency within the meaning of the Constitution of Maine and require the following legislation as immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety; now, therefore,

14 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

15 Sec. 1. 5 MRSA §57, sub-§7 is enacted to read:

16 <u>7. Compensation. Board members are entitled to compensation for expenses only</u>
17 pursuant to section 12004-I, subsection 2-G.

18 Sec. 2. 5 MRSA §12004-I, sub-§2-G is enacted to read:

22 **Emergency clause.** In view of the emergency cited in the preamble, this 23 legislation takes effect when approved.
