1	Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:
2 3	Sec. 1. 10 MRSA §1020, sub-§2, as enacted by PL 2007, c. 464, §6, is amended to read:
4 5	2. Creation; sources of fund. The Waste Motor Oil Revenue Fund is established. The fund consists of:
6	A. All money appropriated for inclusion in the fund;
7 8	B. Subject to any pledge, contract or other obligation, all interest, dividends or other pecuniary gains from investment of money in the fund; and
9 10	C. Any other money available to the authority and directed by the authority to be paid into the fund; and.
11	D. All revenue received from the State Tax Assessor pursuant to subsection 6.
12	Sec. 2. 10 MRSA §1020, sub-§6, as enacted by PL 2007, c. 464, §6, is repealed.
13	SUMMARY
14	This bill repeals the premium imposed on motor vehicle oil changes.
