1 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

2 Sec. 1. 30-A MRSA §4372 is enacted to read:

3 §4372. Municipal waiver option

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By vote of its legislative body, a municipality may waive its right to apply the
provisions of this subchapter at any time. A vote taken at a town meeting or by a city
council must be approved by the citizens at a referendum.

SUMMARY

8 The bill adds an option for a municipality to waive the right to apply the provisions of 9 the Informed Growth Act at any time by its legislative body. The bill also requires that if 10 the vote was taken at a town meeting or by a city council, it must be approved by the 11 citizens at a referendum.
