COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "B" to S.P. 763, L.D. 1969, Bill, "An Act To Raise the Per Diem Rate for Members of the Board of Environmental Protection and the Maine Land Use Regulation Commission"

Amend the bill by striking out the title and substituting the following:

'An Act To Raise the Meal Allowance for Members of the Board of Environmental Protection and the Maine Land Use Regulation Commission'

Amend the bill by striking out everything after the enacting clause and before the summary and inserting the following:

'Sec. 1. 5 MRSA §12004-D, sub-§1, as enacted by PL 1987, c. 786, §5, is amended to read:

Maine Land Use Regulation Commission

Legislative Per Diem Plus Expenses.

12 MRSA §683

Notwithstanding any limitation on noontime meal expenses in section 12002, subsection 2, for each day in attendance at a commission meeting or hearing, each member is entitled to a meal allowance not to exceed the legislative meal allowance for each session day as provided for in Title 3, section 2.

#### Fiscal Detail and Notes

This legislation includes an Other Special Revenue Funds allocation to the Board of Environmental Protection of \$3,600 annually beginning in fiscal year 2008-09 for increased meal allowance expenses. Additional costs associated with expenses of the Land Use Regulation Commission can be absorbed by the Department of Conservation utilizing existing budgeted resources.
