- Sec. 1. 38 MRSA §585-E, sub-§6, as amended by PL 2001, c. 233, §§1 and 2, is further amended to read:
- 6. Section repeal. No later than April 1, 2002 the department shall provide to the joint standing committee of the Legislature having jurisdiction over natural-resources matters an appropriate date for the repeal of this This section is repealed August 1, 2008.
