COMMITTEE AMENDMENT " \mathcal{A} " to S.P. 771, L.D. 1977, "Resolve, To Establish a Statewide Protocol for the Early Detection and Treatment of Autism" 9 10

11 Amend the resolve by striking out everything after the title and before the summary 12 and inserting the following:

13 'Sec. 1. Work group. Resolved: That the Department of Education and the Department of Health and Human Services shall convene an interdepartmental work 14 15 group to develop and establish a uniform statewide protocol for screening children from 18 to 30 months of age for signs of autism, to examine models that meet criteria for 16 17 evidence-based clinical trials to support individual young children with the diagnosis of 18 autism served through the Child Development Services System and to examine the 19 interdepartmental system for capacity and service availability. The interdepartmental 20 work group shall report to the joint standing committees of the Legislature having jurisdiction over education and cultural affairs and health and human services matters by 21 22 January 15, 2009. The joint standing committees of the Legislature having jurisdiction 23 over education and cultural affairs and health and human services matters may submit 24 legislation to the First Regular Session of the 124th Legislature.'

25 **SUMMARY** 26 This amendment replaces the resolve. It requires the Department of Education and 27 the Department of Health and Human Services to convene an interdepartmental work 28 group to develop and establish a uniform statewide protocol for screening young children 29 for signs of autism. The work group is also directed to examine models that meet criteria 30 for evidence-based clinical trials to support individual young children with the diagnosis 31 of autism served through the Child Development Services System and to examine the 32 interdepartmental system for capacity and service availability. The work group is directed 33 to report to the joint standing committees of the Legislature having jurisdiction over 34 education and cultural affairs and health and human services matters by January 15, 2009.
