1 2	Emergency preamble. Whereas, acts and resolves of the Legislature do not become effective until 90 days after adjournment unless enacted as emergencies; and						
3 4	Whereas, the 90-day period may not terminate until after the beginning of the next fiscal year; and						
5 6	Whereas, the poison hotline provides life-saving and cost-effective health information to tens of thousands of callers each year; and						
7 8 9	Whereas, funding for the poison hotline, operated by the Northern New England Poison Center, is overly reliant on private contributions and uncertain state and federal grants; and						
10 11 12	Whereas, failure to provide adequate funding in the last quarter of the state fiscal year will reduce the ability of the Poison Hotline to provide life-saving and cost-effective services; and						
13 14 15 16	Whereas, in the judgment of the Legislature, these facts create an emergency within the meaning of the Constitution of Maine and require the following legislation as immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety; now, therefore,						
17	Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:
