4 This bill is a concept draft pursuant to Joint Rule 208.

5 The bill proposes to create a state bracelet program similar to the one now in the
6 counties. The state program would also be able to accept qualified inmates from county
7 jails that do not live in the county where incarcerated. This bill would also require that a
8 prisoner participate in the New Horizons Academy program.
