COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1405, L.D. 2021, Bill, "An Act To Continue the Maine Military Family Relief Fund Voluntary Checkoff"

Amend the bill in section 1 in §5288-A in subsection 2 in the 4th and 5th lines (page 1, lines 15 and 16 in L.D.) by striking out the following: "but not exceeding \$2,000 annually."

Amend the bill by inserting after section 2 the following:

Sec. 3. Appropriations and allocations. The following appropriations and allocations are made.

Fiscal Detail and Notes

This bill reestablishes the voluntary tax checkoff for the Maine Military Relief Fund which sunset on December 31, 2007. It includes an allocation for grants from the Maine Military Family Relief Fund to eligible families of persons who are members of the Maine National Guard or Maine residents who are members of the Reserves of the Armed Forces of the United States.

Maine Revenue Services will require a General Fund appropriation of \$5,000 in fiscal year 2008-09 to support the administrative costs associated with the Maine Military Relief Fund income tax checkoff.
