Amend the amendment in Part B by inserting after section 2 the following:

'Sec. B-3. Report on test projects. The Department of Marine Resources shall  
12 submit a report by May 1, 2009 to the joint standing committee of the Legislature having  
13 jurisdiction over marine resources matters on the progress of any pilot water quality test  
14 project undertaken pursuant to section 2 of this Part. The committee may submit  
15 legislation based upon the report to the First Regular Session of the 124th Legislature.'

Amend the amendment by relettering or renumbering any nonconsecutive Part letter  
17 or section number to read consecutively.
