
Amend the amendment in section 1 in the last line (page 1, line 20 in amendment) by striking out the following: "2008; and be it further" and inserting the following: '2008.'

### Fiscal Detail and Notes

This amendment removes the General Fund appropriations from the bill. With no additional funding, the Department of Marine Resources will be required to enforce the new rules regarding the sale of shellstock by a harvester to wholesale seafood license holder utilizing existing budgeted resources.
