13 'Sec. 1. Sale of shellstock by a harvester to a wholesale seafood license holder. Resolved: That the Commissioner of Marine Resources shall adopt routine 14 15 technical rules pursuant to the Maine Revised Statutes, Title 5, chapter 375, subchapter 2-A necessary to allow the holder of a commercial shellfish license to safely sell 16 17 shellstock to a wholesale seafood license holder at locations in addition to a permanent 18 facility. The commissioner shall report to the joint standing committee of the Legislature having jurisdiction over marine resources matters on the activities related to this section 19 20 by October 15, 2008; and be it further
