1 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:**

2 **Sec. 1. 23 MRSA §1013** is enacted to read:

3 **§1013. Use of liquid calcium chloride prohibited**

4 The use of liquid calcium chloride on any state highways, state aid highways or town  
5 ways is prohibited for preventing snow from encumbering the highways or town ways.

6 **SUMMARY**

7 This bill bans the use of liquid calcium chloride on all roads in the State for snow  
8 removal.
