SENATE AMENDMENT "B" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1455, L.D. 2071, Bill, "An Act To Amend Maine's Scallop Laws"

Amend the amendment in the 9th indented paragraph in the first line (page 2, line 1 in amendment) by striking out the following: "or 2007" and inserting the following: ', 2007 or 2008'

Amend the amendment in the 11th indented paragraph in the first line (page 2, line 4 in amendment) by striking out the following: "March 3" and inserting the following: 'May 1'

Amend the amendment by striking out all of section 8 (page 2, line 35 and page 3, lines 1 to 24 in amendment).

Amend the amendment by relettering or renumbering any nonconsecutive Part letter or section number to read consecutively.

**SUMMARY**

The amendment increases the number of people eligible to obtain a scallop fishing license by increasing the eligibility period from between 2005 and March 3, 2008 to between 2005 and May 1, 2008. The amendment also strikes the language that deals with drag width.
