11	Amend the bill by striking out the title and substituting the following:
12 13	'An Act To Protect Vulnerable Children by Allowing the Use of Asthma Inhalers and Epinephrine Pens'
14 15	Amend the bill by striking out everything after the title and before the summary and inserting the following:
16 17	'Emergency preamble. Whereas, acts and resolves of the Legislature do not become effective until 90 days after adjournment unless enacted as emergencies; and
18 19 20	Whereas, municipal employees and volunteers working in a municipality's summer recreational program need to be allowed and trained to administer asthma inhalers and epinephrine pens before the 2008 summer recreational program begins; and
21 22 23 24	Whereas, in the judgment of the Legislature, these facts create an emergency within the meaning of the Constitution of Maine and require the following legislation as immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety; now, therefore,
25	Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:
26	Sec. 1. 30-A MRSA §3108 is enacted to read:
27	§3108. Asthma inhalers and epinephrine pens
28 29 30	Municipal employees and volunteers that operate or assist in any municipal recreational program or camp may receive training on how to administer asthma inhalers and epinephrine pens. Municipal employees and volunteers may possess and administer

prescribed asthma inhalers and epinephrine pens in order to provide emergency aid.

## COMMITTEE AMENDMENT " to H.P. 1470, L.D. 2084

**Emergency clause.** In view of the emergency cited in the preamble, this legislation takes effect when approved.'

This amendment changes the title and replaces the bill.
