8 HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1481,
9 L.D. 2095, Bill, "An Act To Ensure the Freedom of Family Child Care Providers To
10 Jointly Negotiate with the State"

11 Amend the amendment in section 1 in §8308 in subsection 1 in paragraph C by
12 striking out all of subparagraphs (5) and (6) and inserting the following:

13 '(5) Member dues deduction; and'

14 Amend the amendment in section 1 in §8308 in subsection 1 in paragraph C in
15 subparagraph (7) in the first line (page 2, line 4 in amendment) by striking out the
16 following: "(7)" and inserting the following: '(6)'

17 Amend the amendment in section 1 in §8308 in subsection 1 in paragraph C in
18 subparagraph (7) in the 2nd line (page 2, line 5 in amendment) by striking out the
19 following: "(6)" and inserting the following: '(5)'

20 Amend the amendment in section 1 in §8308 in subsection 3 by striking out all of
21 paragraph E and inserting the following:

22 'E. Unless prescribed or controlled by federal law or regulation, the State and the
23 collective bargaining agent of family child care providers may agree through
24 negotiations to deduct membership dues from child care subsidy payments. A family
25 child care provider who is not a member of the organization of the collective
26 bargaining agent may not be charged a representation fee, service fee or fee of any
27 other kind. A fee may not be charged against the subsidy payment of a family child
28 care provider without the consent of that family child care provider.'

29 Amend the amendment by relettering or renumbering any nonconsecutive Part letter
30 or section number to read consecutively.

SUMMARY

32 This amendment provides that a family child care provider who is not a member of
33 the organization of the collective bargaining agent may not be charged a representation
34 fee, service fee or fee of any other kind. It further provides that a fee may not be charged
