19 20 21 22 23	This amendment grandfathers the membership, as of May 1, 2008, of an active regional or local family child care provider association incorporated as a nonprofit corporation with the Secretary of State. This grandfathered status allows but does not require the local association members to elect to become a member of the collective bargaining agent or to pay service fees pursuant to the collective bargaining agreement.
