13	'2. Call of meeting. When 4 or more parcels of land are benefited by a private road
14 15	private way or bridge as an easement or by fee ownership of the private road, private way or bridge, the owners of any 3 or more of the parcels, as long as at least 3 of the parcel
16	are owned by different persons, may make written application to a notary public to call
17	meeting. The notary may issue a warrant or similar written notice setting forth the time
18	place and purpose of the meeting. Copies of the warrant or similar written notice must be
19	mailed by means of the United States Postal Service to the owners of all the parcel
20	benefited by the private road, private way or bridge at the addresses set forth in th
21	municipal tax records at least 30 days before the date of the meeting. If mailing copies o
22	the warrant or similar written notice to all such owners is not possible, the notary shall
23	post a notice in a public place. The notice must inform the owners of the planner
24	meeting's agenda and specify all items to be voted on. Subsequent meetings may be
25	called in the same manner or by a commissioner or board appointed at a previous meeting
26	pursuant to subsection 5.

SUMMARY 27

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This amendment incorporates the changes made by Senate Amendment "A" except that it removes language requiring the mailing of proxy forms or posting of information regarding proxy forms. It removes the language that stipulates that a person acting as a

1 proxy may not be an owner of a parcel benefited by the private road, private way or

2 bridge that is the subject of the meeting. It, like Senate Amendment "A", does not
