COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1491, L.D. 2105, Bill, "An Act To Change the Timing of the Health Care Occupations Report and To Add and Clarify Definitions Relating to Swimming Pools and Spas"

Amend the bill in section 8 in §2666 by striking out all of subsection 1 (page 3, lines 34 and 35 in L.D.) and inserting the following:

~~'1. Employment; communicable disease. No person having a communicable disease may be employed or work at a public swimming pool or spa.'~~

SUMMARY

This amendment changes the bill by repealing the Maine Revised Statutes, Title 22, section 2666, subsection 1, which prohibits a person having a communicable disease from working at a public pool or spa.
