purchase of colorectal cancer screening for individuals who are:

5 <u>A. Fifty years of age or older;</u>

6 B. Less than 50 years of age and at high risk for colorectal cancer according to 7 applicable colorectal cancer screening guidelines; or

8 C. Less than 50 years of age and symptomatic for colorectal cancer or other colon
9 diseases.

2. Application. The requirements of this section apply to all policies, contracts and
certificates executed, delivered, issued for delivery, continued or renewed in this State on
or after January 1, 2009. For purposes of this section, all contracts are deemed to be
renewed no later than the next anniversary of the contract date.

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SUMMARY

This bill requires health insurance policies, contracts and certificates to provide coverage for colorectal cancer screening. The provisions of this bill apply to all policies, contracts and certificates issued or renewed on or after January 1, 2009.
